<b>Aim:</b>	Review of study words

<b>Time:</b>	15
<b>Materials:</b>	no
<b>Outline:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Tell the students that you have a puzzle for them. You are thinking of a word, and you are going to give them clues one at a time for that word.
